

## Core Element 5: Version

### Definition:

Element in a numbered sequence that the work being cited forms part of (*MLA Handbook* 39).

### Treatment:

Identify the version after the title. Follow text by a comma.

Sample versions: 2nd ed., Updated ed., Unabridged version, version 1.3. (39-40).

### Examples:

*Collins Quotation Finder*. Rev. ed., HarperCollins Publishers, 2001.

Gordimer, Nadine. Interview. *The New York Times*, late ed., 10 Oct. 1991, p. C25.

Miller, Casey, and Kate Swift. *Words and Women*. Updated ed., HarperCollins Publishers, 1991.

SarDesai, D. R. *Vietnam: Past and Present*. 3rd ed., Westview Publishers, 1998.

Sinha, D. "Indigenizing Psychology." *Handbook of Cross-Cultural Psychology*, edited by John W. Berry et al., 2nd ed., vol. 1, Allyn and Bacon, 1997, pp. 129-62. *Google Books*,
