

Citation Examples for “Works Cited” List

At the end of your paper, you must provide an alphabetical listing of all the works you have cited in your paper. This requirement includes both work you have actually quoted and work you have summarized or paraphrased. The information is arranged alphabetically according to the author’s last name or, when there is no author identified, by title.

Basic Elements

Published interviews

Interviewee’s Last Name, Interviewee’s First Name. “Title of Interview.” Interview by Name of Interviewer, if available. *Title of Interview Source* [periodical or book or website], date of interview, additional bibliographic information and/or URL. Interview [if not evident].

Unpublished interviews

Interviewee’s Last Name, Interviewee’s First Name. Description. Interviewer. Date.
